Clark County, Nevada Amateur Radio Emergency Service Application



Thank you for your interest in applying for membership in the Clark County, NV, Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) and the Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service (RACES).

BEFORE YOU APPLY

By applying to Clark County ARES (CCNVARES), you agree to have CCNVARES "enroll" your station's capabilities with the Clark County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) to facilitate participation under RACES rules (ref 47 CFR 97.407 and 97.111(a)(4)). This would allow the OEM to activate you to one of their subordinate responsibilities (Multi-Agency Coordination Center, EOCs, hospitals, fire stations, etc.) and allows you to use amateur radio frequencies to contact federal agencies in support thereof. The OEM or other agencies control access to their own facilities, may require an application, may do a background check and issue their own credentials (badges). CCNVARES will catalog your demonstrated station capabilities (voice & digital) and provide periodic reports to the OEM so they know the scope of available resources and activate appropriate operators.

The ARRL has adopted the **ARES Strategic Plan**, (http://www.arrl.org/ares-plan), that sets out the qualifications for membership in ARES through three levels of training. Each level you complete better enables you to accomplish our emergency communications mission, and helps you to understand how we fit in to the Incident Command System used by our served agencies. CCNVARES addendums to the national level are listed at the end of this document. **Level 3** prepares members for leadership positions and is not be covered here.

Level 1 is the entry skill level for those new to amateur radio or emergency communications. You will receive introductory training on the Clark County ARES mission, emergency communications (EMCOMM) procedures and equipment. New ARES members are asked to complete Level 1 within **three months** of application. Applicants who do not complete Level 1 within six months without coordination with CCNVARES staff will be assumed to have terminated their application process. Remaining at Level 1 may limit your access to facilities of our served agencies. You will not receive a Clark County ARES/RACES identification card at this level.

Level 2 is the baseline skill level for full membership in Clark County, Nevada, ARES/RACES. Our goal is that every member accomplishes the requirements for Level 2 within one year of application. To renew your membership, you must complete all requirements for Level 2. At this level, you will receive a Clark County ARES/RACES identification card and will be identified to our served agencies as demonstrating sufficient skills to meet their requirements.
